Project Scope

- Tonkin Highway (between Great Eastern Highway and Roe Highway) widened to six lanes.
- Leach Highway (between Orrong Road and the Perth Airport) upgraded to an expressway standard.
- New interchanges constructed at:
 - o Tonkin Highway / Leach Highway
 - o Tonkin Highway / Horrie Miller Drive / Kewdale Road
 - Leach Highway / Abernethy Road
 - o Tonkin Highway / Dunreath Drive
- Interchange upgraded at:
 - o Tonkin Highway / Roe Highway
- New on-ramp constructed between Abernethy Road and Tonkin Highway southbound.
- Local road improvements in the Kewdale Industrial Precinct.
- Intersection upgrades at:
 - Abernethy Road / Kewdale Road
 - o Abernethy Road / Noble Street
 - o Kewdale Road / Fenton Street
 - o Kewdale Road / Miles Road
 - o Orrong Road / Division Street / Ballantyne Road
 - o Miles Road / Ballantyne Road
 - o Miles Road / Bell Street
- Principal Shared Path network for pedestrians and cyclists.

Project Overview

- The Gateway WA project was the largest road project to date to be undertaken by Main Roads Western Australia.
- The project delivered a suite of road network upgrades to improve freight and passenger movements around Perth Airport and the nearby Kewdale and Forrestfield industrial estates.
- The project has provided an iconic 'gateway' to the city of Perth, connecting residents, visitors and businesses through a safe and efficient road network.
- Gateway WA was jointly funded by the Australian (\$676 million) and State (\$310 million)
 Governments.
- Main Roads awarded the Alliance contract by competitive tender in November 2012 to Gateway WA which comprised industry leaders; CPB Contractors (formerly Leighton Contractors), Georgiou, GHD, AECOM and BG&E.
